The enactment of U.S. Congress HR 4173, specifically with regard to section 1502- Conflict Minerals, addresses serious concerns within the supply chain for raw materials. Scientific Systems, Inc. We are in ongoing communication with our main suppliers, both manufacturers and distributors, and it is clear that all suppliers are moving toward enactment and compliance.
